

# Report from the meeting in Hungary

(25<sup>th</sup> – 29<sup>th</sup> September)

- **Tasks**

Most of things have been done this time.

Set a deadline to complete the previous parts: **until the end of October**

Lessons should be uploaded in two weeks so every school can test them.

**Deadline: 15th October**, but at the end of October everything must be completed.

Most of the lessons were CLIL lessons, they were ok.

It is possible to come back to the previous lessons, try them and comment them.

The higher the number of lessons commented the better.

- **Website**

**Meetings:** there should be everything, lessons taught at that school, workshops, seminars, etc..

Every article written about the meetings should be on the website, add links of the articles.

At the end of the project, everything should be on the website, easier to find and see.

**Methodology:** when you test a lesson, the name of the teacher should be on the comment. Videos and pictures can be added on the comments.

**Gallery:** Upload a few pictures or just add a link with the pictures to the gallery.

- **Dissemination part of the application: things that haven't been done**

**Erasmus Day:** it's on the project, it must be done at the end of the meeting. You should invite parents, teachers from other schools, you can include games, competitions about the countries. You must present the project to the local community.

**Forum of debate created on Facebook:** the forum would be open to everybody. It could be multilingual (not all the parents speak English).

**Promotional short video of the project:** Spain will make it, all the partners will collaborate sending pictures, videos, material, etc.

**Calendar:** for the year 2019, it should be done after the project. It is a dissemination tool. It will be done after the meeting in Greece, it will be discussed there.

- **Meeting in Czech Republic:**

**Dates:** from the 5th to the 9th February.

It is better to take a plane to Prague, probably the partners will be picked up there.

Train for Hungarian partners: 140€ from Budapest, there is a direct train to Děčín (Česká Lípa is half an hour driving).

**Deadline** to send the number of teachers and students: **at the end of October** (the sooner the better).

Include name of the kids + female/male + emails, (indicate if some of the students already hosted a Czech student in the previous meetings).

Greece must have an invitation until the end of October (including the name of teachers and students).

- **Making the most of the budget:**

For the Greece Meeting teachers budget is taken from the Transnational Meeting 575€ (760€ for Portugal) for 2 teachers.

Take more teachers and students if you calculate that you're going to have some money left.

It is possible to move 20% of each section of the budget to the other sections. However, it is NOT possible to ADD anything into Project management and Implementation.

For the transnational meeting, probably you will need more money for teachers mobility, it could be taken from the management budget.

- **Meeting in Greece:**

**Dates:** from the 23rd to the 27<sup>th</sup>, April.

Number of students and children will be sent at the end of February.

Nearest airport to Volos: Thessaloniki (2 hours driving)

Athens airport is 4 hours driving.

Trains: there is no direct train to Volos.

All schools agree to stay one day later to visit Athens (that means leaving on Sunday 29th, April).

A "Hop on Hop off" Bus will be arranged to visit Athens all together.

- **Topics for the next set of materials:**

**Maths:** Constructing Triangles (more than one lesson would be great)

More lessons on the website are welcome, it doesn't matter if the topic is finished.

We can add lessons made in the exchanges meetings.

**Physics:** Constructions connected with water (ex. Archimedes theorem)

At least 1 lesson for each subject must be uploaded.

They must be uploaded **before the end of November**, tested and commented before the end of February.

- **Last Topic: Geography/History/Civics**

**Geography:** one lesson about something interesting of your country.

**History:** one lesson about ancient history

**Civics:** one lesson for customs and traditions in our countries

One lesson for each. They should be uploaded to the website **until the end of March**, tested and commented before the meeting in Greece.

- **Exchange of mascots:**

- Spain takes the Greek mascot.
- Greece takes the Portuguese Mascot.
- Portugal takes the Czech mascot.
- Hungary takes the Spanish mascot.
- Czech Republic takes the Hungarian mascot.
